Who may apply for this scholarship? Who is eligible?

- Green Hill Academic School graduates that have received their High School diploma and
- Have placed a 4 or 5 in reading and/or writing on the HSPE exam, demonstrating college readiness.

What must the person do to apply?

Submit a typed double spaced essay of at least 500 words but not more than 750 words on how incarceration has transformed you and what you would like to do with your education now and in the future.

When is the application due?

This scholarship is unique in that the application due date is ongoing. Green Hill Academic School has graduates leaving throughout the school year because its students are serving different lengths of sentences and this scholarship is intended to work to help graduates enter into the nearest college quarter or semester.

*Are applications only submitted by current students prior to their release?

How do you evaluate the applications? How do you announce the winner?

* Applications that have met the eligibility requirements and submitted an essay will be reviewed by school staff, winners will be chosen based upon essays after applications are reviewed.

The winner(s) will be announced in writing.

* Will you send a formal letter, announce it through the winner's school, personal visit? By the way, are you going to notify the applicants that didn't win?
